Subject: 2019 Ithaca Youth Baseball & Softball Registration Information

It's that time of year again and the winter sports have wrapped up. Baseball & Softball seasons are just around the corner which brings us to the first step: REGISTRATION. Registrations for youth Baseball & Softball will be done via US Mail (or hand delivery) and are due by Friday, March 24, 2019. The fees will remain at \$20 for K4 – 2^{nd} grade boys / girls and \$25 for $3^{rd} - 8^{th}$ grade boys / girls with a maximum of \$50 per family. If utilizing the maximum rate per family, all registrations <u>must</u> be submitted together. Please fill out a separate registration form for each child. These forms are given to the player's coach for contact information, so please write legibly on them. Registration checks should be made payable to "Ithaca Youth Baseball".

The Ithaca Youth Baseball club took over the girls youth softball program in 2015. Our goal is to keep the program running & get the girls some much needed experience. Youth softball girls $(3^{rd} - 8^{th})$ will be registering through the <u>Ithaca Youth Baseball</u> club, but will be playing Softball. Depending on the number of girls out in each age group, we may or may not have softball teams in the league. 3^{rd} through 8^{th} grade girls will play Softball and 3^{rd} through 8^{th} grade boys will play Baseball.

If your child is interested in playing youth baseball or softball, we encourage you to have him / her participate at a young age, preferably no later than 3rd grade, to develop skills and an understanding of the game.

The Southwest Wisconsin Coaches League will be having their Spring league meeting the first week in April and we need to know how many teams in each age group Ithaca Youth Baseball will have, including girls softball. That's the reason for the early registration deadline. <u>If you register late, your child is not guaranteed to be added to a team.</u> This has been a continual problem over the past few years. If the teams are filled up, late registrants <u>will</u> be rejected. If additional players are *needed* to fill up a team, we may make exceptions. It will depend on how many players we have in each of the age groups. If there are 16 or 17 players on a team and someone signs up late, their registration will likely be rejected. The final decision will be made by the Club. Late registrants who are allowed by the Club, will be assessed a <u>\$20.00 late fee</u> and will <u>not</u> be allowed to play until paid.

Ithaca Youth Baseball has a "Code of Conduct" that must be adhered to. All players and parents are expected to strictly follow the rules of this Code of Conduct. By wearing Ithaca apparel or uniforms, you are representing the rest of us too so conduct yourself accordingly. Violations (by players or parents) will not be tolerated and may result in single or multiple game suspensions. The Code of Conduct is attached at the end of this document and is expected to be signed by the parent / guardian of each player. Players will not be allowed to participate in practices or games until the Code of Conduct is signed and returned. Your registration will be considered incomplete until the Code of Conduct is received. One Code of Conduct form can be completed per family.

Ithaca Youth Baseball officers are as follows: Steve Louis, President; Darrick Marchwick, Vice President; Jane Kepler, Secretary; and Holly Nelson, Treasurer.. We are ALWAYS looking for additional volunteers to help out with different things.....concessions, uniforms, registrations, field preparation, equipment, apparel orders, cooking for home games, etc. Please do your part to help out. If interested, please contact an officer or your child's coach.

Ithaca Youth Baseball will be having their next club meeting around the first of April. If you would like to be involved, please keep an eye on the school announcements for the date and time. An e-mail will likely be sent out to previous contacts from the youth baseball club. We would like to thank everyone (sponsors, parents, stepparents, grandparents, siblings, players, coaches, umpires, etc.) for making the 2017 season a great success.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PLAYER INFORMATION

Uniforms provided by Ithaca Youth Baseball are for players' use during the Southwest Summer League season. 3rd through 8th grade uniforms should only be worn during league and tournament games – not to practice or school.

Players are responsible for care and upkeep of their uniform. At the end of the season, K4-2 players will keep their T-shirts while 3rd through 8th graders will return their jerseys and pants. 3rd, 5th, and 7th grade players will receive new caps; while 4th, 6th, and 8th grade players will keep their caps. Players who do not return their uniform with be assessed an \$80.00 replacement fee. Baseball gloves, batting gloves, shoes, belts and socks are the players' responsibility. All other equipment will be provided by Ithaca Youth Baseball.

Players' parents are asked to support Ithaca Youth Baseball through volunteering for preparing food and/or running the concession stands at home games, preparing playing fields, assisting coaches during practices and games, umpiring bases at home games, keeping score book, providing first aid, and assisting in fundraising efforts to assure all program costs are covered. Players and parents are expected to strictly follow the Ithaca Youth Baseball Code of Conduct. Violations of the Code of Conduct (by parents or players) may result in game suspension(s).

I give my child, ______, permission to play organized baseball in the Ithaca Youth Baseball program. I agree to the terms and conditions stated above, and I understand that the Ithaca Youth Baseball program, the Southwest Wisconsin Coaches League (SWCL), it's organizers, and coaches are not liable for any injuries incurred during scheduled practices, games, or tournaments. If I am unavailable, I authorize the coach or his/her designee to seek medical attention for my child.

Registration fees will remain at \$20 for K4 - 2nd grade boys / girls and \$25 for
3 rd - 8 th grade boys / girls with a maximum of \$50 per family. Checks should

be assessed for late registrants (no exceptions).
