

Before WICW can begin underground construction, it's required for the property owner and/or authorized representative to provide us with a map showing relative locations of all private facilities in potential construction paths. It may include sewer and water lines, propane lines, underground electrical wiring, underground dog fencing, telecom lines, sprinkler systems, and/or other electrical lines beyond the property.

Underground construction cannot begin until this form is filled out completely, signed and returned to Wiconnect Wireless along with the installation payment of \$150 and a map of private utilities.
